WORKING SAVED HIS LIFE

Christian was headed down a dark path, but generous supporters like you have guided him toward success.

Growing up, Christian remembered his parents were always working to keep things afloat. He spent most of his time alone and unsupervised, eventually making friends with the wrong crowd.

"I felt depressed, so I hung out with people that made me feel good about myself. I didn't realize it at the time, but hanging out with them was when I started to get into trouble."

Christian first experimented with drugs when he was 15. Eventually, he dropped out of high school and continued using until he was 22.

"I finally hit rock bottom. I didn't want to live like this anymore. I needed help." Your support helped Christian break out of this cycle.

When he enrolled in Hope Builders' Information Technology training program, Christian took advantage of the supportive services.

"There was always a staff member there ready to help me deal with any of my struggles. Knowing that someone has your back helped me get through the training. I didn't need to rely on drugs to fix my problems anymore."
